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6 **A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY WAIVING ANNEXATION FEES AND FOR OTHER**  
7 **LAWFUL PURPOSES**

8 **WHEREAS**, the City of South Fulton (“City”) is a municipal corporation duly  
9 organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia;

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11 **WHEREAS**, the duly elected governing authority of the City, is the Mayor and  
12 Council thereof (“City Council”);

13 **WHEREAS**, the City Council is authorized under state and local law to establish  
14 administrative and regulatory fees;

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16 **WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to temporarily waive annexation application  
17 fees through this Ordinance while such costs are further assessed; and

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19 **WHEREAS**, this Resolution is in the best interests of the health and general  
20 welfare of the City, its residents and general public.

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22 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON,**  
23 **GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES** as follows:

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25 **Section 1.** The City hereby waives its annexation application fees through August  
26 1, 2019.

28 **Section 2.** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that: (a)  
29 All sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Resolution are or  
30 were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable  
31 and constitutional.

32 (b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence,  
33 clause or phrase of this Resolution is severable from every other section, paragraph,  
34 sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution. No section, paragraph, sentence, clause  
35 or phrase of this Resolution is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph,  
36 sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

37 (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this  
38 Resolution shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or  
39 otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent  
40 jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity,

41 unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not  
42 render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining  
43 phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Resolution.

44 **Section 3.** All Resolutions and parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby  
45 expressly repealed.

46 **Section 4.** The effective date of this Resolution shall be the date of adoption unless  
47 provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.

48 **Section 5. Instruction to City Clerk:** The City Clerk is hereby directed to circulate  
49 a copy of this Resolution to the Department of Community Development and Regulatory  
50 Affairs promptly following its adoption.
