5 **RESOLUTION TO AMEND PERSONEL OVERTIME AND COMPENSATORY TIME**  
6 **POLICY SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR A LIMITED AND SPECIFIC EXCEPTION**  
7 **APPLYING TO INSTANCES IN WHICH EXTERNAL FUNDING HAS BEEN MADE**  
8 **AVAILABLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**  
9

10 **WHEREAS**, the City of South Fulton has established rules and policies governing the  
11 administration and availability of overtime pay and the accrual of compensatory time; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council desire to provide for an exception regarding the  
13 availability of overtime pay in instances where external funding has been made available to  
14 reimburse the City for the paying of such overtime.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved by the Mayor and**  
16 **City Council as follows:**

17 **Section 1.**

18 Provisions of the City of South Fulton personnel policies relating to the availability and payment  
19 of overtime shall be amended to provide as follows:

20 Departments of the City that receive funding from external funding sources for reimbursement of  
21 payments by the City for overtime hours shall be permitted, to the extent of such external  
22 funding and in accordance with the terms and conditions for which such external funding is  
23 being made available, to allow employees to be paid overtime pay; provided, further, that  
24 provisions for the accrual of compensatory time shall not apply when covered employees are  
25 paid for overtime hours and the City is reimbursed for such payments from external funding  
26 sources.

27 **Section 2.**

28 This Resolution shall become effective when approved and all resolutions and parts of  
29 resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.


