

**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
REALLOCATE FUNDING FOR CITY ANNIVERSARY AND JUNETEENTH
CELEBRATIONS, AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES**

(Sponsored by Councilmembers Willis, Rowell, Sebastian, Williams, Gumbs)

WHEREAS, the City South Fulton ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to celebrate Juneteenth and the heritage of its African-American residents, a majority of which are descendants of African slaves; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to celebrate the incorporation of the City of South Fulton on its founding date of May 1, 2017;

WHEREAS, this Resolution is in the best interests of the general welfare of the City and its employees and residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA, that the City Manager is directed to reallocate up to Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$220,000.00) at her discretion to plan City celebrations of its anniversary and Juneteenth.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that City procurement guidelines must be adhered to in selecting any vendors for the celebrations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions or parts thereof that are in conflict with this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the effective date of this Resolution shall be from the date of adoption, unless provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.

MAYOR'S SIGNATURE PAGE

The mayor, within ten (10) business days following receipt of an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council shall return it to the city clerk with or without the mayor's approval or with the mayor's veto. If an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council has been approved by the mayor or if it is returned to the city clerk neither approved nor disapproved, it shall become law upon its return to the city clerk. However, if the mayor fails to return an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council to the city clerk within ten (10) business days of receipt, it shall become law at 12:00 Midnight on the tenth business day after receipt. If the ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council is vetoed by the mayor, the mayor shall submit to city council, through the city clerk, the reasons for the mayor's veto. The city clerk shall record upon the ordinance the date of its delivery to and its receipt from the mayor.
