

**A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CITY RENAMING COMMITTEE TO AN  
ADDITIONAL ONE YEAR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**(Sponsored by Councilperson Willis)**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council established City Renaming Committee to consider requests and make recommendations to the City Council for the naming or renaming of City facilities or infrastructures, excluding roads through Resolution 2021-033; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to extend the term of the Renaming Committee for an additional one year beyond the original six months term; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is in the best interests of the general welfare of the City and its employees and residents.

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES** as follows:

**Section 1.** The City of South Fulton, Georgia hereby extends the City Renaming Committee for an additional one year to effectuate the purpose established through Resolution 2021-033.

**Section 2.** The City Attorney and City Clerk are authorized to make non-substantive editing and renumbering revisions to this Resolution for proofing, codification, and supplementation purposes. The final version of all resolutions shall be filed with the City Clerk.

**Section 3.** All resolutions, or parts thereof, that conflict with this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** The effective date of this Resolution shall be from the date of adoption, unless provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.



## MAYOR'S SIGNATURE PAGE

The mayor, within ten (10) business days following receipt of an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council shall return it to the city clerk with or without the mayor's approval or with the mayor's veto. If an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council has been approved by the mayor or if it is returned to the city clerk neither approved nor disapproved, it shall become law upon its return to the city clerk. However, if the mayor fails to return an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council to the city clerk within ten (10) business days of receipt, it shall become law at 12:00 Midnight on the tenth business day after receipt. If the ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council is vetoed by the mayor, the mayor shall submit to city council, through the city clerk, the reasons for the mayor's veto. The city clerk shall record upon the ordinance the date of its delivery to and its receipt from the mayor.
