

**A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE STREET RENAMING TASK FORCE COMMITTEE
TO ONE YEAR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

(Sponsored by Councilperson Gumbs)

WHEREAS, the City Council established a task force committee (“Task Force”) to research and review names of streets within the City that may be associated with or linked to the atrocities that occurred during the Civil War and the Confederacy, to work with the community on proposed name changes and present its findings and recommendations for name changes to City Council through Resolution 2021-032; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to extend the term of the Task Force for an additional one year beyond the original six months term; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is in the best interests of the general welfare of the City and its employees and residents.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:

Section 1. The City of South Fulton, Georgia hereby extends the Streets Renaming Committee Task Force for an additional one year to effectuate the purpose established through Resolution 2021-032.

Section 2. The City Attorney and City Clerk are authorized to make non-substantive editing and renumbering revisions to this Resolution for proofing, codification, and supplementation purposes. The final version of all resolutions shall be filed with the City Clerk.

Section 3. All resolutions, or parts thereof, that conflict with this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4. The effective date of this Resolution shall be from the date of adoption, unless provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.

MAYOR'S SIGNATURE PAGE

The mayor, within ten (10) business days following receipt of an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council shall return it to the city clerk with or without the mayor's approval or with the mayor's veto. If an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council has been approved by the mayor or if it is returned to the city clerk neither approved nor disapproved, it shall become law upon its return to the city clerk. However, if the mayor fails to return an ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council to the city clerk within ten (10) business days of receipt, it shall become law at 12:00 Midnight on the tenth business day after receipt. If the ordinance, resolution, or other action adopted by the city council is vetoed by the mayor, the mayor shall submit to city council, through the city clerk, the reasons for the mayor's veto. The city clerk shall record upon the ordinance the date of its delivery to and its receipt from the mayor.
