

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE CREATION OF A CHARTER COMMISSION TO REVIEW THE CITY'S EXPERIENCE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON ANY CHANGES TO THE CITY CHARTER; IDENTIFY THE NAMES OF THE APPOINTEES TO THE COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES

(Sponsored by Councilmembers Willis, Gumbs, Williams, Reeves)

WHEREAS, the City of South Fulton ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7.18 of the City Charter, the Mayor and City Council five years after the inception of the City of South Fulton, the mayor and city council shall call for a charter commission to review the city's experience and recommend to the General Assembly any changes to the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, members of the charter commission shall be appointed as follows: one by the mayor, one by the city council, and one by each member of the Georgia House of Representatives and Senate whose district lies wholly or partially within the corporate boundaries of the City of South Fulton; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is intended to be consistent with the Charter and also in the best interest of the welfare of the City, its businesses, visitors and residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA, that a charter commission is hereby created to review the City's experience and recommend to the General Assembly any changes to the City Charter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the members of the charter commission shall be appointed as follows: one by the mayor, one by the city council, and one by each member of the Georgia House of Representatives and Senate whose district lies wholly or partially within the corporate boundaries of the City of South Fulton.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all members of the charter commission must reside in the City of South Fulton.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following individuals are appointed to the charter commission as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the commission must complete the recommendations within six months of the effective date of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the commission shall make its recommendations in writing directly to each member of the Georgia House of Representatives and Senate whose district lies wholly or partially within the corporate boundaries of the City of South Fulton.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the effective date of this Resolution shall be from the date of the mayor's signature.




