a. V20-007 6470 Beaver Creek Trail

Zoning Administrator Nathan Mai-Lombardo gives the power point presentation for this petition. He concludes that staff recommends approval of the applicant's request to reduce the front yard setback from 20 feet to 15 feet because of a sewer easement at the rear of the property.
