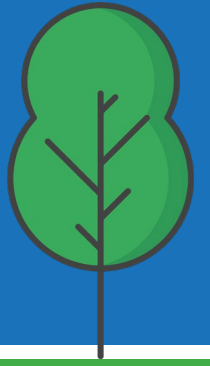


CLEANER, GREENER SOUTH FULTON *Mascot Contest*



One of the first steps toward keeping a **Cleaner, Greener South Fulton** is to engage the City's youth and teaching them the importance of community cleanliness and its environmental impact.

To accomplish this goal, we're launching a contest for students in grades K-12 to help us develop a mascot that will be the symbol of our "Cleaner, Greener South Fulton" campaign.

The mascot should be a champion of:

- Cleanliness
- Community pride
- Teamwork

- Five finalists will be named by April 5, 2019
- Winner will be selected by April 16, 2019 and announced/named at the April 23, 2019 City Council regular meeting
- Winner receives a \$250 gift card and a chance to serve as honorary Mayor for the day
- Finalists artwork to be displayed at City Hall in April 2019

CONTEST RULES

- The contest is open to students who live or go to school in the City of South Fulton Grades K-12.
- Artwork must be your own; the use of copyrighted or inappropriate images is prohibited.
- By entering the contest, participants give the City of South Fulton permission and rights to reproduce the artwork. Artists will retain the rights to their work.
- Entries will be judged based on creativity, campaign relevance and visual impact.

TO ENTER

- Include your name, age and grade, school, home address and phone number.
- Entries from students under age 13 should be submitted by a teacher or parent.
