



CALL FOR SPECIAL ELECTION CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA

NOTICE is hereby given to voters residing within the municipal boundaries of the City of South Fulton, Georgia, that a Special Election will be held on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2019, for the purpose of submitting the following questions to the qualified voters for their determination:

The ballot questions will read as follows:

QUESTION 1:

- Yes** Shall the Act be approved which authorizes the City of South Fulton to utilize tax allocation districts and redevelopment powers under the 'Redevelopment Powers Law,' as it may be amended from time to time?
- No**

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on such question are for approval of the Act, then Section 1 of this Act shall become of full force and effect immediately. If more than one-half of the votes cast on such question are for rejection of the Act or if the election is not conducted as provided in this section, then Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective and this Act shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately following that election date.

QUESTION 2:

- Yes** Do you approve a new homestead exemption from City of South Fulton property taxes for municipal purposes in the amount of the difference between the current year assessed value of a home and its lowest base year value, provided that the lowest base year value will be adjusted yearly by the lesser of 3 percent or the inflation rate?
- No**

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and those persons desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on such question are for approval of the Act, Section 1 of this Act shall become of full force and effect on January 1, 2020. If the Act is not so approved or if the election is not conducted as provided in this section, Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective and this Act shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately following that election date.
