(CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA, October 24, 2019) Municipal Election Day for City of South Fulton is Tuesday, November 5, 2019. Early voting for the 2019 Municipal Election began Tuesday, October 15, 2019, and will continue through Friday, November 1, 2019. The complete dates for early voting for the 2019 Municipal Election are:

- Tues. October 15, 2019 to **Friday, October 25, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**
- **Sat. October 26, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**
- **Mon. October 28, 2019 to Friday, November 1, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

City of South Fulton encourages residents to learn their ballots before they arrive to the polling location. Voters will make decisions on Tax Allocation Districts (TAD) and Homestead Exemptions in the City of South Fulton. The 2019 Municipal Election Candidates for the City of South Fulton include:
