This week, the mayor and city council will partner with the Atlanta Community Food Bank, Coca Cola Bottling Company, Renaissance Church of Christ and the Delta Mu Mu Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Inc. to distribute food to South Fulton residents. In addition, State Farm will sponsor \$500 worth of personal protective equipment for volunteers.

Residents will be able to drive through the site to safely pick up food, which will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.
