### **Organizers to hold Feeding the City of South Fulton on a New Day**

**What:** Feeding the City of South Fulton Initiative

**Who:** City of South Fulton Mayor and City Council in partnership with the Atlanta Community Food Bank, GFL Environmental, Coca Cola Bottling Company, State Farm and Purest Hygiene

**Details:** (City of South Fulton, GA – June 2, 2020) – This Friday South Fulton leaders will partner for a fifth week to assist residents impacted by the COVID-19 crisis in a community food distribution called Feeding the City of South Fulton. Residents will be able to drive through the site to safely pick up food, which will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

This week, the city will partner with the Atlanta Community Food Bank, GFL Environmental, Coca Cola Bottling Company and State Farm. In addition, Purest Hygiene will be on hand to distribute free hand sanitizer and share the company's pledge, which asks people to commit to:

- Avoid touching objects in public spaces.
- If you must touch, sanitize before and after touching objects
- Always clean your hands and nails before touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.

“Our city continues to go to great lengths to lend assistance with not only medical and testing needs, but nutritional needs,” Mayor William “Bill” Edwards said. “We are committed to ensuring families have the proper nourishment throughout this pandemic.”

“I am grateful for our partners’ support in providing food to the South Fulton community and gear for volunteers,” said Councilwoman Helen Willis. “These partnerships will help us supply the demand of food for residents who have been impacted by the COVID-19 crisis.”
