New Hope Road Roundabout Scheduled to Open to Traffic

(CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GA – May 19, 2021) – After nearly two months of construction, the roundabout at the intersection of Campbellton and New Hope roads is scheduled to open to traffic on Tuesday, May 25.

Contractors with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) started work on the project in February. Officials also will re-open the southern intersection of New Hope and Boat Rock roads next week.

“Drivers will have access to all three legs of the roundabout - New Hope Road, Boat Rock Road and State Route 166,” said Antonio Valenzuela, director of public works for the City of South Fulton. “

Before the open date, GDOT work crews will complete repaving and temporary restriping in the construction zone. Drivers are asked to reduce their speeds for the safety of crews and pedestrians. Motorists can expect delays and are encouraged to use caution when severe weather causes traffic to increase.

While the road will remain open, work on the intersection continues. In coming months, crews will install curbed sidewalks, a drainage system and they will complete landscaping of the roundabout. The project is expected to reach full completion by the end of September.
