Police Chief Meadows to be Honored as Social Justice Champion at EBONY Power 100 Awards

(City of South Fulton, GA – October 6, 2021) – In a career that spans four decades, City of South Fulton Police Chief Keith Meadows has received his share of accolades.

Now, he can add Social Justice Champion to that list as one of nine people – including U.S. Sen. Raphael Warnock, whose district includes the city – who will receive the award when the EBONY Power 100 returns Oct. 23.

“Throughout my career, I’ve worked to ensure people feel safe in their neighborhoods and that justice is served for crime victims,” Meadows said. “While these pursuits have been reward enough, I’m honored to be counted among the amazing honorees being recognized for their invaluable contributions to society.”

Meadows was named police chief in July 2018. He had led the College Park Police Department for three years prior after a 30-year career with the Atlanta Police Department. He ultimately commanded Atlanta’s Major Crimes Section, which includes the homicide, special victims, major fraud, commercial robbery, school detectives, auto theft and fugitive units.

Planned for Los Angeles, EBONY Magazine’s star-studded awards ceremony will honor the remarkable achievements of African Americans across various disciplines. It marks the culmination of the iconic brand’s 75th Anniversary year.

“After what has been a most challenging and turbulent year, this year’s nominees and honorees represent a wide range of people who persevered and continue to do the work,” said CEO Michele Ghee. “In doing so, they have contributed immensely to their respective fields and communities - making a significant impact on the cultural landscape each in their own ways.”

EBONY will present awards in nine other categories, including Entertainment Powerhouse, Music Impact, Excellence in Journalism, Ceiling Breaker, Games Changer, Innovation Leader, Community Builder, Breakthrough Creators and NextGen.
