

## **CIVIL RIGHTS TITLE VI STATEMENT**

The City of South Fulton, under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes, ensures that no person on the grounds of race, color, age, disability or national origin, shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity. The City further assures that every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination in all of its programs and activities, whether those programs and activities are federally funded or not.

In the event the City distributes federal aid funds to another entity, the City will include Title VI language in all written agreements and will monitor compliance.

## **LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY POLICY STATEMENT AND AVAILABLE RESOURCES**

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. § 2000d, et seq., provides that no person shall be subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin under any program or activity that receives Federal financial assistance. Title VI and its implementing regulations require that recipients of Federal financial assistance take responsible steps to ensure meaningful access to the benefits, services, information, and other important portions of their programs and activities for individuals with Limited English Proficiency (LEP).
