**CITY OF SOUTH FULTON CHARTER CHANGE RECOMMENDATIONS**

<b>Section</b>	<b>Recommended Change</b>	<b>Date</b>
Section 1.11	A map of the City indicating the boundaries of the City (including street-level detail) should be included in Section 1.11 as Appendix A for the simplicity of understanding for the general public.	8.1.2022
Section 2.11	A new section (h) is added to Section 2.11 that requires that the mayor and city councilmembers submit at least once per year on or before June 30 their current legal residential address to the City Clerk to continuously establish their city residency. A friendly amendment was added to the motion to require proof of residency.	8.1.2022
Section 2.11	The Charter shall include the residency criteria as used by the Fulton County School System as acceptable proof of residency for the mayor and councilmembers.	8.16.2022
Section 2.12 (c)	Section 2.12 (c) is amended to add language that allows the city council to appoint an interim councilperson until the next legal election can be held.	8.1.2022
Section 2.12 (c)	Language shall be added to specify that in the event of a vacancy, each councilmember may recommend no more than one nomination for the vacant position, the nomination must be district specific, unless the vacancy occurs in one of the at-large districts and each nominee must be eligible to run for office as prescribed in Section 2.10.	10.4.2022
Section 2.10 A	Section 2.10A is revised to read that there shall be a part-time mayor and seven part-time councilmembers of which two will be at-large.	8.16.2022
Section 2.16 A	An amendment to Section 2.16A to remove “other appointed officers” only from the section.	8.16.2022
Section 2.16 A	An amendment to Section 2.16A provides that failing to maintain residency in the city is added as an additional reason for removal from office.	10.4.2022
Section 3.25	Throughout the Charter for consistency of language, especially Section 3.25, the term suspend or terminate should be used instead of suspend or removal.	8.16.2022
Section 3.25	Add the word suspend only allow the city manager to “suspend” (add that word) or remove (that word needs to be consistent throughout the Charter – use remove rather than terminate) with approval from majority of City Council. To comply with 8.16 vote, the word “terminate” will be used for consistency.	11.1.2022
Section 3.28	Violations of this section are spelled out in the section as an ethics violation and a reference made to Section 6-A1.	8.16.2022
Section 4.12	Amend section to provide the same process for removal of City Manager in Sec.3.23 for City Attorney.	11.1.2022
Section 4.12 (c)	Amend section to provide the same process for confirmation of the City Attorney’s compensation to match the confirmation by City Council of the City Manager’s compensation.	11.1.2022
Section 4.13	Section 4.13 provides that the Mayor shall nominate the city clerk and the city council shall confirm the appointment.	9.20.2022
Section 4.14	The city council shall confirm the appointment of the finance director by the city manager and provide for the compensation of the finance director.	9.20.2022
Section 4.14	Add sections to the charter for the positions of Assistant City Manager and Human Resources Director. The language for each position will be “The city council shall confirm the appointment of the Finance Director, Human Resources Director and the Assistant City Manager by the city manager” in each section.	10.4.2022
Section 5.11	Language shall be added to require a residency requirement in the City of South Fulton for the chief judge of the municipal court.	10.4.2022

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Section 6.A.1	Section 6.A.1 is amended to add a requirement that to file an ethics complaint in the City of South Fulton, the filer must be a resident, an elected official or the city clerk of the City of South Fulton.	10.4.2022
Section 6-A.4	Every councilmember shall have two appointments, one of which shall be an attorney. Each ethics panel shall consist of three members and would have a minimum of one attorney on each ethics panel as selected randomly by the city clerk.	9.20.2022
Section 6-A.4	Line e of Section 6-A.4 is amended to reflect that each ethics panel have at least one attorney and one citizen on each ethics panel as selected randomly by the city clerk.	10.4.2022
Section 6-A.4	Line e, (2) of Section 6-A.4 is amended to strike “with no less than three of those years dedicated to general civil litigation practice.”	10.4.2022
Section 7.18	A review of the city charter shall occur every five years, or sooner as deemed necessary by the city council. The method of selection shall remain the same as the current selection process for the charter commission.	9.20.2022
Section 7.18	Add language from Section 4.11(d) excluding the language prior to the first comma into Section 7.18. “No member of any board, commission, or authority shall hold any elective office in the city.”	10.18.2022
Section 7.18	Amend language to – No member of the charter commission shall hold any elective office in the city.	11.1.2022
